
Frontal Cortex/Lobe: One of the four lobes of the brain (subdivision of the forebrain), located behind the forehead, above the eyes, which is important for language, planning, reasoning, voluntary movement (e.g. lifting and drinking a glass of water), and associated with certain aspects of memory.
