Mismatch negativity (MMN): A component of the event-related potential that occurs in response to infrequent changes in an ongoing stream of sounds, and is thought to reflect updating of sensory memory. MMN occurs to changes in frequency, intensity, duration, timbre, sound location, higher-level pattern.
