Type II diabetes: This is a chronic (lifelong) disease marked by high levels of sugar (glucose) in the blood. In type 2 diabetes, either the body does not produce enough insulin (an hormone produced by the pancreas that regulates the level of glucose) or the cells ignore the insulin.
